Project Background

The City of Toronto and Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) are undertaking a design exercise to revitalize the Governor's Bridge Lookout at Don Valley Brick Works Park.

Several issues with the Governor's Bridge Lookout have been of concern to City of Toronto staff for some time, such as vandalism, informal paths and shortcuts, vegetation damage, and non AODA compliance. Due to these concerns, City of Toronto staff and TRCA are planning a design revitalization of the Lookout that will better suit current and future use of Don Valley Brick Works Park as visitor numbers and pressures continue to grow.

Governor's Lookout is closely associated with the GBRA, who helped fundraise and advocate for the park during its development, and currently includes a recognition plaque, as will the new design.
